Other precautions include disposing properly of sharp items and other contaminated material, and cleaning and disinfecting surfaces and equipment in the treatment room before each patient.

Our infection control system has been thoroughly designed to provide you with a safe, comfortable dental environment. Our staff members are also thoroughly trained in infection control procedures and are constantly updated as new techniques evolve.
